Flash estimate - July 2013

Euro area annual inflation stable at 1.6%

Euro area¹ annual inflation² is expected to be 1.6% in July 2013, stable compared with June³, according to a flash estimate⁴ from **Eurostat**, the statistical office of the European Union.

Looking at the main components of euro area inflation, food, alcohol & tobacco is expected to have the highest annual rate in July (3.5% compared with 3.2% in June), followed by energy (1.6%, stable compared with June), services (1.4%, stable compared with June), and non-energy industrial goods (0.4% compared with 0.7% in June).
