Subject: Follow-up on latest developments in the Greek negotiations

Following the outcome of the Eurogroup meeting on 11 May 2015, ECON Coordinators held an exchange of views as regards the latest developments in the ongoing negotiations between the Greek authorities and the institutions.

ECON Coordinators consider that the European Parliament, as the EU forum for democratic debate, must enable an open and transparent discussion in this regard.

Based on these considerations and after having political consultations, it is proposed as a first step to invite the key stakeholders involved in the Greek crisis, including Greek Prime Minister, to a plenary debate.

In view of the urgency of the matter, I would like to suggest that this item be considered at the forthcoming meeting of the Conference of Presidents, for approval.
